

North swimmers post another sectional win

2 ANDERSON — Muncie Northside romped to its third straight sectional swimming title here Saturday, easily disposing of 12 team opponents.

The Titans, scoring in every event and winning both the important relay races, scored 332 points. Eight Titans qualified as individuals for the state finals next Saturday at the Ball State pool in Muncie, as well as both North relays teams.

Anderson was second with 223 points, qualifying three individuals and both relays teams. Other team scores with

state finals qualifiers in parentheses:

Richmond 183 (3), Connersville 136 (2), Greenfield Central 104, New Castle 67, Hagerstown 62 (1), Pendleton Heights 35, Yorktown 27, Madison Heights 15, Muncie Southside 10, Muncie Central 8, Muncie Burreis 2.

The individual star of the meet was Northside's Greg Beyerl, who broke two of the six sectional records set, all by Titan swimmers.

Beyerl's records came in the 200-yard individual medley with a 2:04.6 clocking and the 100-yard backstroke, :57.3. Beyerl also swam with the Titans' winning 200-yard medley relay team that also included Phil Perry, Tom Schranz and Jim Hall and set a sectional record of 1:43.64.

Another record was set by North's 400-yard freestyle relay team of Schranz, Robin Culin, Scott Reed and Hall, which churned the distance in 3:09.7.

Other individual record-setters were Schranz with a :55.32 mark in the 100-yard butterfly and Keith Peterson with a 5:05.7 time in the 500-yard freestyle.

North's state meet qualifiers along with members of the two relay teams are Culin, 200-yard freestyle; Beyerl, 200-yard individual medley and 100-yard backstroke; Peterson, 200-yard individual medley and 500-yard freestyle; Kenneth Brady, diving; Schranz, 100-yard butterfly; Hall, 100-yard freestyle, and Perry, 100-yard breaststroke.

ANDERSON — Favored Muncie North qualified its entire team in the IHSAA sectional swimming trials here Thursday night and in doing so set four sectional standards.

Finals will get under way at 2 p.m. Saturday in the Anderson High School pool in the Wigwam.

First 12-place finishers advanced to the finals with the top six relays teams also qualifying.

Setting records were Greg Beyerl, 2:05.5 in the 200-yard individual medley and :57.76 in the 100-yard backstroke; Tom Schranz, :56.13 in the 100-yard butterfly, and Phil Perry, Jim Hall, Beyerl and Schranz, 1:44.67 in winning the medley relay.

Hall tied the sectional mark of :51.88 in the 100-yard freestyle.
